Introduction to Canvas for Students Module

- The Academic Commons made a student-facing Canvas orientation module available in Canvas Commons.
 - The Introduction for Canvas for Students module highlights common tasks students may need to complete as part of their coursework.
 - Instructors can easily insert this module into their courses as a pre-course assignment or optional resource. Detailed below are instructions to including this module:
 - Navigate to **Commons** in the Global Navigation Menu to the far left.
 - Select the **Filter** button in the upper right corner.
 - Select Modules then scroll down to the Shared With section and select Jefferson.
 - Click on the Introduction to Canvas for Students module
 - Select the blue Import/Download button and follow the prompts to import the module into the appropriate course.
